

Geoff Merrill G & W Cabernet Sauvignon 2006By Campbell Mattinson

It's a multi-regional blend - 65 percent McLaren Vale cabernet with 35 percent Coonawarra cabernet. It spends time in both French and American oak - though it shows very little sign of either.

Terrific focus. Forget the regions - this is all about the muscular glory of the cabernet sauvignon grape. It tastes of leaves and mint and earth and blackcurrant. It's got plenty of flavour. And yet it has a strict, neat, absolute sense of control to it. Naturally, it's quite tannic. As it should be. Ripper.
